Vaccines for Children (VFC)

We provide free vaccine and low-cost vaccine administration for eligible children including uninsured, underinsured, Native American and Alaska Native.

Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines available upon request.

CDC has approved a 3rd dose of the mRNA vaccine for anyone who is moderately to severely immunocompromised. It must be given at least 28 days after the 2nd dose.

A booster dose of the Pfizer vaccine must be given at least 6 months after the 2nd dose. It has been approved for:

- People 65 and older
- People 18-64 with underlying medical conditions or who are at increased risk of COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of occupational or institutional settings.

A booster dose of the Moderna vaccine has not been approved yet.

The 2021- 2022 available vaccines include:

- Influenza Quadrivalent injections for ages 6 months and over, including High Dose Quadrivalent for seniors
- FluMist for ages 2-49 years old

Available by Special Request

- Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine 2 dose series (18 and older)
- Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine 2 dose series (FDA approved for 16+, EUA approved for 12–15-year-olds)
- Shingrix for ages 50+. 2 dose series
- Tdap tetanus, diphtheria, whooping cough
