

Sacred Heart Elementary Christmas Program Information

Dear Parents,

The **Elementary Christmas Program "Carriers of the Light"** will be on **Monday, December 13th, 6:30pm** in the school gymnasium.

Students are asked to dress in the following colors:

- **Kindergarten** (sheep) - brown, red, orange, or gray t-shirt/shirt/sweater (no big words or logos please) and black, brown, or gray jeans/pants/leggings.
- **1st Grade** (innkeepers) - brown, blue or gray t-shirt/shirt/sweater (no big words or logos please) and blue, black, brown, or gray jeans/pants/leggings.
- **2nd Grade** (angels) - white, pale blue or gray t-shirt/shirt/sweater and white, blue, or gray jeans/pants/leggings.
- **3rd Grade** (innkeepers & Shepherds) - brown, red, orange, or gray t-shirt/shirt/sweater (no big words or logos please) and black, blue, brown, or gray jeans/pants/leggings.
- **4th Grade** (donkey/the road to Bethlehem) - red or green t-shirt/shirt/sweater (Christmas prints are fine) and black, brown, or gray jeans/pants/leggings (blue jeans are accepted but black, brown or gray colors are preferred).
- **5th Grade** (animals in the stable) - Some students have their own animal costumes which they can wear, and a more detailed list will come out for those dressing in a specific animal color, otherwise students should please wear all black pants/leggings/skirt or dress with tights (shades of gray are also acceptable). Students dressing in black, may optionally wear accessories that accent the colors red, silver or gold (bracelet, necklace, hairclip, tie, ribbon, scarf, hat).
- **6th Grade** (narrators & opening and closing scene) - school-appropriate dress up clothes, all colors are fine, no jeans. Can be dress pants with a collared shirt, school-appropriate Christmas sweaters are also acceptable, and black or gray pants/leggings, or skirts/dresses with tights.
